The Sodus Bay Yacht Club is proud to be the host of the 2008 Central New York Sailing Association Annual Regatta. Racing will be held on Great Sodus Bay and Lake Ontario.

Rules

This Regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (2005-2008), except as modified by the Sailing Instructions.

Classes

This Regatta is open to all boats of the **Optimist,(Saturday Only)**, 420, Laser, Laser Radial, Ideal 18, and Lightning Classes. All other classes are available to participate. A minimum of five boats in a class shall be registered to establish a fleet.

Eligibility and Entry

Boats may register at the Registration desk on Friday, July 11, and Saturday July 12, 2008 at the times listed below. The Skippers over 16 years of age should be members of USSA or CSA. Non-members will pay a \$5.00 additional fee.

Schedule of Regatta

Friday, July 11	1830-2100 Registration (Registration desk is located at the Sodus Bay Junior Sailing Facility, SBJSA)
Saturday, July 12	0700-0845 Registration open 0915 Skippers Meeting 1030 Warning Signal for the first class on each course. Opti One Day Regatta. 1830 approx. Opti Awards , Dinner
Sunday, July 13	1000 Warning Signal for the first class on each course. 1300 No race shall start after this time. Presentation of awards following the race.

Fees

The following registration fees apply to all classes:

- Boats with one person \$25
- Boats with two person \$35
- Boats with three person \$45
- Boats with four or more person \$50

A membership number is required. Non USSA or CSA members over 16 add \$5.00.

Registration forms will be available at the registration desk as well as the Central New York Sailing Association website after May 1st 2008.

Housing

There will be **limited** space for trailers, RV, and tents on the SBYC/SBJSA property, on a first come, first serve basis. Off-site boat trailer parking is mandatory.
